- Assessing a rooftop, identifying and clearly documenting the risks
- Conveying identified risks to the solar panel cleaning team
- Safely accessing rooftops using either ladders, access routes or stairwells
- Cleaning solar panels using solar panel cleaning equipment
- Setting up appropriate rope access equipment when required on sites, as identified during the H&S process
- Any other reasonable duties as assigned from time to time
